#### 1. Unpack the printer

\* When tearing off the protective film over the printhead or putting the printhead into the carriage unit, do not touch the metal contact area on the back of cartridge or the metal nozzle at the bottom of printhead, protect the printhead from falling. If a drop occurs, the printhead may be damaged. B. Remove the foam inside the carriage unit.



D. Put the new printhead into the right position in the carriage unit.



E. Press hard the carriage unit cover to close the carriage unit



\* After installing the printhead, do not remove and install the printhead multiple times, otherwise it will cause other problems such as abnormal images.

#### 3. Install the ink bottle

A. Take out colored ink bottle



C. Place the ink bottles downwards and insert them firmly into the lnk bottle slot accordingly; make sure the bottom of the ink bottle parallel to the edges.

#### **Replace the Printhead**

1. Open the operation panel(Do not open the operation panel at the time of printing)

- 3. Take out printhead upward



2. Open clip of carriage unit







5. Put the new printhead into the right position in the carriage unit.



\* After installing the printhead, do not remove and install the printhead multiple times, otherwise it will cause other problems such as abnormal images.





Do not touch the metal contact area on the back of cartridge or the metal nozzle at the bottom of printhead

#### Clean the printhead

• If the printhead is blocked, the output of printing will become vague, and there will be visible stripes or unexpected colors.

• When print quality degrades, use check function to check whether there is any blockage. If so, please clean printhead, which will consume large quantity of ink.

#### Important

• Do not open operation panel or turn off the product in cleaning printhead. Printing cannot be started before the c leaning is completed.

• Since cleaning printhead consumes some ink, please do it only when the print quality degrades.

• If printer lies idle for a long time, printhead will dry up or be blocked. It is recommended to use the printer once every half a month at least.

• Check the pattern, and clean printhead if necessary.

• If the pattern on the testing page is more similar to Pattern (B), the pattern is incomplete. If the quality is unsatisfying, printhead can be cleaned again.

#### Clean the manuscript desk

- 1. Moisten a piece of clean and lint free soft cloth.

- 3. Use a piece of dry and lint free cloth to wipe off the residual moisture.

#### Paper Jam Treatment

#### ▲ Caution

Please make sure that the paper you use conforms to the specification of paper recommended by Deli. Please refer to "Print Media" on page 19

Make sure that the paper in the paper feed tray is completely flat. If the paper still curls, please replace the paper.

Make sure the paper in the paper feed tray is of a proper quantity. Too much paper may cause paper jams. (The paper feed tray can be loaded with 120 sheets of 70g/m2 plain paper.)

#### ▲ Caution

Avoid any unnecessary touch to parts that are sensitive in equipment when cleaning paper jams.

Firmly grasp the two sides of jammed paper, and then gently pull it out.

Be careful to avoid tearing the paper when removing it.

#### **Print Quality Improvement**

#### ▲ Caution

Please use genuine Deli printhead and ink bottle. Using other brands of printhead and ink bottle may affect print quality. Please check USB interface and network cable interface to make sure that they are connected well. The following suggestions are aimed at addressing various image quality problems



#### Photo Paper Is Placed Reversely, And Causes Blurred Printing Colors

Make sure that the "photo paper" is suitable for color inkjet printers and compatible with dye inks (do not use photo paper with a thermal sublimation printer type). For the type of photo paper, it is recommended to use 180g and above matte RC photo paper.

Make sure to use the front (printed side) of the photo paper for printing.

For details, refer to the photo paper package or instructions, for example:

1. Generally, the brand logo will be printed on the back of the photo paper to distinguish it from the front.

2. If there is no brand logo, the smooth surface is usually the printed surface; or use two fingers to pinch the photo paper, and release it after a few seconds. The side sticking to the hand is usually the front of the photo paper. (Because the front has the ink receptive coating layer, it is more sticky.)



Make sure the photo paper is properly placed in the paper box; Make sure that the front of the photo paper is facing outwards (or upwards), and the back touches to the baffle plate when it is put into the paper box. At the same time, adjust the blue plate in the paper box to clamp the photo paper correctly.

#### **Printer Transportation**

#### In case the printer is moved to a nearby location

1. Press and hold the Power key for 3 seconds to turn off the printer.

Please lift the lock timely after handling to make the printer in a printing status.
