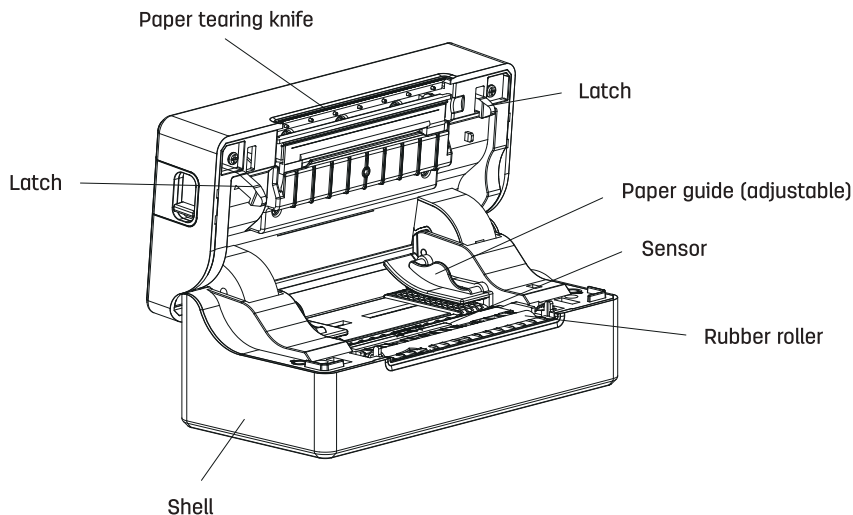

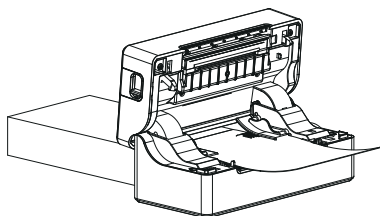
3 Loading the Paper Roll

1. Place a paper roll into the rear of the printer so that it is in the middle of the paper guide.

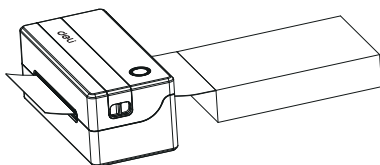
2. Face the front of the printer, press the top cover button in the direction of the arrow, and lift the top cover up.



3. Pull out some paper through the paper guide, adjust the paper width guide against both edges to fasten the paper.

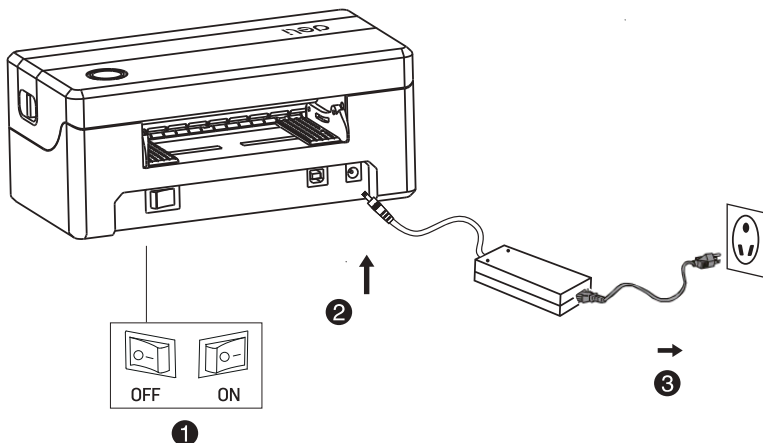


4. Press down the top cover until it clicks shut and tear excess paper in the tear-off direction.



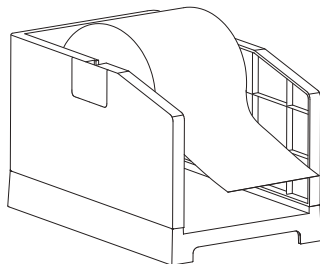
4 Power Connection

1. Make sure that the power switch is at the OFF (O) position.
2. Connect the power adapter to the printer.
3. Connect the other end of the power cord to a nearby outlet.



5 Tips

1. For use of paper rolls, we recommend the Deli Waybill Box 15208.
2. We recommend using Deli-brand consumables to protect your print head.



6 Button function setting

It could carry out simple operation to the printer by the button.

Power Off	Press and hold + turn on the printer	Print self-test page
Standby	Press and hold 3S	Enter label specification learning mode
Open the cover	Press and hold 10 S	Restore factory settings
Standby	Press	Automatically feed one blank label sheet
Continuous printing process	Press	Pause printing
Pause printing	Press	Continue printing
